WEEKLY APPLICATION POINT—

“Faith that Gets Up and Goes Back to God”

This week, reflect on where you might be carrying shame or guilt from past mistakes or failures. Remember David’s story: even though he sinned deeply, he didn’t stay in failure—he came back to God in humility and received His grace.

Practical Prayer Step: Each day, take a moment to confess honestly to God—no matter what you’ve done—and ask Him to renew your spirit and help you rise again in faith. Trust that His grace is bigger than your mistakes, and let that truth shape how you live, love, and lead this week.

INDIVIDUAL REFLECTION QUESTIONS

1. How can David’s story inspire me to keep faith alive—even when life feels messy or I feel far from God?
2. What daily habits help me guard my heart from becoming superficial or performative in faith?
3. What are some ways I can remind myself daily that my worth is rooted in Christ, not my achievements or failures?
4. How can I encourage others who struggle with self-worth from a biblical perspective?
5. How can I practice forgiveness toward myself and others to reflect God’s grace?
