1. SPIRITUAL RESET BEGINS BY REMEMBERING _____ IN CHARGE.

Psalm 24:1-2

True reset doesn't begin with what we do—it begins with who God is.

2. SPIRITUAL RESET REQUIRES A _____ CHECK.

Psalm 24:3-4

We settle for behavior modification instead of heart transformation.

The reset Jesus offers doesn't start with better behavior—it starts with a new heart.

3. SPIRITUAL RESET OPENS THE _____ TO BLESSING.

Psalm 24:5-6

This isn't just about individual transformation. It's about collective revival.

But a heart RESET by Jesus becomes a holy spark.

APPLICATION STEP –

Read this with me... God, if You want to start a move of Your Spirit, You can start it in me.

Will you surrender and let Jesus reset your heart—not just for you, but for the sake of everyone your life touches?

Questions for Further Study

2. What's the difference between external behavior change and internal heart transformation?
 - Read: Matthew 23:25–28, Ezekiel 36:25–27, 1 Samuel 16:7
 - Why do you think God cares more about heart motives than surface-level obedience?
3. What does it mean for you personally to have “clean hands and a pure heart”?
 - Read: James 4:7–10, Psalm 51:10–12, 2 Corinthians 7:1
 - Are there any actions or attitudes God is inviting you to surrender or confess?
4. What kind of “blessing” does God promise to those who seek Him?
 - Read: Matthew 5:6–8, Jeremiah 29:13, Psalm 84:11
 - How is this blessing different from worldly success or comfort?
5. How does seeking God's face differ from simply asking for His help?
 - Read: Psalm 27:4, Hosea 10:12, Hebrews 11:6
 - What does it look like for you to pursue God wholeheartedly?
